Megawati Wijaya landed her first job in an oil and gas firm after her graduation in 2015. She shares with Bond how the MDIS experience contributed to her people skills at the workplace.



Having graduated in 2015 with a Bachelor of Science (Hons) in Accounting and Finance from the University of Bradford, Megawati Wijaya now works in the oil and gas industry. Her role requires her to contribute actively to the organisation's administration, finance and human resource functions.

"The market was grim when I graduated, so it was a blessing to have been offered a job in one of the hardest hit industries," Megawati remarked. She recalls how her time at MDIS was beneficial, where her peers were from all over the world and she was exposed to a rich cultural experience.

The lessons from interacting with her schoolmates of various nationalities proved its worth at work. "My employer has offices across the region; I have to work with people from different countries. I report to my finance manager who is based in the Middle East. Working acoss regions is not a barrier for me as my intercultural exposure at MDIS taught me how to work well with people from different countries," Megawati noted.

On campus, Megawati honed her communications skills by serving in the MDIS Business Club as an Executive Secretary supporting the President. Megawati's active involvement in various

affiliations, such as the MDIS Business Club and Badminton Club, strengthened her leadership and interpersonal relation skills, giving her an added edge when she was looking for a job.

"While fresh graduates get their experience only from internships, my involvement in the various Interest Group Club activities at MDIS has equipped me with the necessary interpersonal and leadership skills in preparing me for the workforce. I will always cherish the accessibility and willingness of my lecturers and schoolmates at MDIS who have helped make connections and secured many of the opportunities I had with potential employers," she remarked.

Additionally, Megawati's involvement in the interest groups at MDIS and the interaction with peers from various nationalities helped her become more versatile. She believes this is a quality that will give graduates a headstart in developing soft skills, especially for those who may not have professional experience apart from internships.

For aspiring graduands, Megawati has this piece of advice to offer: "Learning is a journey. Enjoy your time on campus and use every opportunity to do your best. "


